USPS Mail Theft 1600 block of Darby Road

On Thursday, December 15, 2022, at 1:33 AM, Officer Joseph McGibney while on patrol observed a vehicle parked with its headlights activated and a person outside the vehicle by a USPS mailbox in the 1600 block of Darby Road. The person then ran back to the vehicle and entered on the passenger side. The vehicle then proceeded north on Darby Road and as it travelled past the officer, several black male occupants were observed in the vehicle. Due to the recent thefts from mailboxes, Officer McGibney attempted to conduct a vehicle investigation in the 1700 block Darby Road, but the vehicle fled at a high rate of speed, north on Darby Road and then through neighborhood streets. As the vehicle traveled on Mill Road, mail was observed being thrown from the vehicle. The vehicle continued to flee from police and crashed in the 1600 block of Karakung Drive. Two of the suspects fled on foot and one suspect was apprehended at the scene. Surrounding agencies were notified and Lower Merion Police Officers apprehended the other suspects at City Avenue and Haverford Road.

Haverford Police, Radnor Police and Lower Merion Police recovered numerous pieces of mail along the chase route. The vehicle, a 2017 Dodge Charger, black in color, was impounded and a search warrant was issued. A handgun and two USPS bins of mail were recovered from the vehicle. An overall total of 498 pieces of mail was recovered.

The below listed defendants were charged with Theft, Receiving Stolen Property, Recklessly Endangering Another Person, Resisting Arrest, and Fleeing or Attempting to Elude Officer. They were arraigned and bail was set at \$250,000 (10%). They were transported to George W. Hill Correctional Facility, Delaware County, PA
