
The Court Coordinator



The Court Coordinator is a full time civilian position within the police department. The Court Coordinator is a liaison between the police department and the courts of the Commonwealth. The Court Coordinator is responsible for coordinating officers' schedules with the court calendar to maintain efficient administration of justice while working to reduce costs to the department. The Court Coordinator interacts with the three District Courts that serve Haverford Township along with the Court of Common Pleas in Media, PA on a daily basis. Keith Hall has served as the Departments Court Coordinator for 20 years since 2000 when the department instituted the Court Coordinator Program.

In 2019, the Court Coordinator facilitated the prosecution of four hundred and seven (407) felony or misdemeanor criminal cases at the three district courts. The Court Coordinator also coordinated four hundred and thirty-three (433) summary criminal cases and three thousand seven hundred and ninety-six (3796) summary traffic cases at the District Courts. Mr. Hall also ensured the officers of this department were available for all criminal trials and summary appeals at the Common Pleas Courts including over 150 "On-Call" cases. Mr. Hall also coordinated the transfer of fifty-nine (59) DUI blood samples to the appropriate Laboratories for chemical testing so the officers could effectively prosecute their cases.
